## Academic Information

<b>Instruction Language</b>	Mainly Korean (A few courses taught in English)
<b>Course List</b>	<a href="#">개설과목 확인 (changwon.ac.kr)</a> (All in Korean)
<b>Min/Max credits</b>	Exchange students usually take 3 to 6 courses per semester. Most courses are 3 credits, and one 3-credit course consists of 45-hour workload per semester. Minimum credits allowed per semester is 6 credits. Maximum credits allowed per semester is 21 credits.

<b>Class hours per credit</b>	1 credit = 15 hours / 1 semester (1 semester = 15 weeks)
<b>Transcript</b>	One copy of transcript will be sent to student's home university. If a student need more than one copy, he/she should request for it to IAE staffs before grade release period.

## Application Procedure

<b>Type of Exchange</b>	[Exchange I] Students take regular courses offered by CWNU. [Exchange II] Students can take 10-weeks Korean Language School courses (20hrs/week) and take 1-2 regular course(s) offered by CWNU.
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Students must be nominated by CWNU's partner University.</li><li>▪ Students must be a full-time student in CWNU's partner university</li><li>▪ There are no language requirements, but it is strongly recommended to have high proficiency of Korean or English.</li></ul>

<b>Nomination deadline</b>	Partner universities should submit the nomination form by email. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ For Spring 2024: October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023</li> <li>▪ For Fall 2024: April 29<sup>st</sup>, 2024</li> </ul>
<b>Application deadline</b>	Nominated students should submit online application within the deadline. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Spring Semester: November 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023</li> <li>▪ Fall Semester: May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024</li> </ul>

<b>Admission certificate</b>	Certificate of admission will be delivered to the student's home university after 15-20 days from the application deadline.

Tuition	Exchange students for <b>Exchange I</b> program pay tuition to their home institutions and CWNU tuition is waived. However, exchange students for <b>Exchange II</b> program need to pay discounted KLS tuition directly to CWNU: 800,000won <i>* The above cost are based on the 2021 academic calendar and are subject to change</i>

**Insurance requirement**

All exchange students are automatically signed in National Health Care Insurance after they receive Alien Registration Card. Students can have overseas travel insurance from their home country until they are signed into National Health Care Insurance.
