APPLICANT REQUIREMENT

1. Undergraduate student of partner university with at least 2 semesters completed at home university before applying
2. Minimum GPA of 2.6 on a 4.0 scale

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE

All international students are required to join the Korean National Health Insurance. It is effective from the date of issuance of the Residence Card. It generally takes about 1 month for the Residence Card to be issued. It is strongly recommended that students bring additional insurance coverage from home country for the non-covered period or for the entire period.

HOUSING AND MEALS

International Student Housing costs

Cost per semester (from first to last day of classes; additional charges may apply if student wants to stay until departure date)

Single room:	KRW 1,510,000
Double room:	KRW 1,062,000
Triple room:	KRW 911,111
Quadruple room:	KRW 853,000

Facilities include: single bed, desk, chair, closet, refrigerator, table, shared shoe rack, bathroom, laundry room

Bedding not provided, utilities included

* The above cost is based on 2024-I semester and may increase.

** Space is not guaranteed, and students will be assigned depending on availability. (The housing office will do its best to accommodate student preferences.)

*** Students are required to submit tuberculosis test result (tested negative within 3 months) upon check-in.

Meals

There is no meal plan but students may use the on-campus cafeteria for lunch. On campus meals cost roughly KRW 6,000.

There are a few restaurants near campus and students can shop for groceries online.

There is a kitchen in each housing unit for cooking but there are no utensils.

BUDDY PROGRAM

It is recommended that all international students participate in the Buddy Program. Buddy Program consists of Korean SMU students (single or group) that help out international students and participate in joint activities throughout the semester.

AIRPORT PICKUP

Airport pickup service will be available and pickup details will be notified after admission. Please do not purchase tickets before the notification if you need pickup service.

APPLICATION

All official documents and supplementary materials must arrive at SMU by the deadline without exception – May 15, 2024.

The application will not be processed if any document is missing.

Home University Coordinator must submit student nominations by responding to a survey by the deadline. Nominees must be within the agreed upon number.

3. Original supplementary files by post (see ADDRESS above; home university coordinator may collect and send documents of applicants in one packet)

Supplementary files

1. Study plan (in Korean, explaining why you would like to study at SMU as an exchange student)
2. Financial statement (must be an official bank statement in student's name, issued within 30 days from application submission) – minimum USD 5,000 for 1 semester, USD 10,000 for 2 semesters
3. Official academic transcript in English
4. Home University Certificate of Enrollment

CoE must be accompanied by one of the following: 1. Apostille certification 2. Confirmation by Korean Consul in country of Home University	CHSI official proof of enrollment https://www.chsi.com.cn/

* Students from OECD countries may submit the official CoE issued by Home University.

5. Copy of passport ID page (must not expire until 6 months after the end of the exchange program)
6. Passport photo (with name written on back in pen)
7. Proof of language proficiency (if applicable)
 - TOPIK for Korean Program

PROGRAMS

- Exchange program is in Korean.
- Most courses in the departments listed below are taught in Korean, with a limited number (3 or fewer) of courses offered in English. (see Reference)
- Students may take up to 19 credits per semester.
- Student major will be determined by SMU Coordinator depending on Home University major.

Recommendation

- Students with TOPIK 4/5 will have no problem taking the courses at Sangmyung University. It is strongly recommended that students have at least TOPIK 3 to study at Sangmyung University.
- Home University coordinator must guarantee Korean language proficiency (at least TOPIK 3) for students with no TOPIK score for successful study at SMU.
